



FATHER TEEN ADVENTURE (Daughter) CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT LIST

This list will help you assemble personal gear for your activities during the FTA program. It may seem like there is more than you need, but mountain weather is very unpredictable.

- You will stay at Camp Buxton in framed outfitter tents or small cabins.
- Showers and restrooms are in the nearby bathhouse.
- Limited laundry facilities are available.
- Spring Canyon will provide all gear for cooking and eating.
- You may want to bring some additional items for comfort around Spring Canyon.
- Temperatures may range from the mid 80's during the day to freezing at night. Rain and snow showers are **PROBABLE**, especially at high elevations.
- Remember: "Cotton Kills" in the mountains.
- Cotton clothing, when wet, won't insulate and actually draws away body heat, so you shouldn't plan to use it as an insulating layer on the trek.
- Please do not plan to wear cotton socks during Trek! Synthetic materials (Polypropylene, spandex, polyester blends, or wool socks with liners tend to work best.)





Available for Issue at Spring Canyon Essential items to bring: Please consider bringing: (All items listed here are free of Hiking boots w/ ankle support Rain pants or poncho charge) (Military issue boots are not Liner socks preferred, but are acceptable) Tennis shoes/sneakers Backpack (70 Liter) Wool or synthetic blend hiking Notepad or pen/pencil Sleeping bag w/liner (20 degree) socks (2+pair) Baseball cap Sleeping pad Sunglasses Balaclava or buff (aka "neck Pack fly Beanie hat gaiter") Stuff sacks for sleeping bag Lightweight pair of gloves Pocketknife/multi-tool (Note: Cooking/eating utensils **Swimsuit** Please **DO NOT** bring survival Hiking pants (zip-off legs are Plastic bowls/cups knives/bowie knives, etc.) Nalgene water bottles fine) Camera Sandals with an ankle strap Safety whistles (required by rafting company) Crazy creek camp chairs **Prescription medications** Towel **Bible Contact solution/glasses** Shampoo/conditioner Shaving kit Toothbrush/toothpaste Deodorant Chapstick Flashlight/headlamp Feminine hygiene products **Base Layers:** □ 2 Long sleeve polypro or synthetic shirts 2 Short sleeve polypro or synthetic shirts Long underwear for sleeping Regular underwear Mid Layers: Fleece, wool, or down jacket/pullover (compact/lightweight) **Outer Layers:** Rain Jacket or shell Ceremony: Jacket and tie (Dad) **Sunday/Semi-Formal Dress** (Daughter) Shawl or sweater/cardigan (to pair with dress in case of cool date-night evening)
