Tubing

- Spring Canyon has our own tubing run
- Tubes available for guest use
- Ask at the Front Desk when the tubing run is open (only open if there is enough snow and when staff is available to monitor)
- No tube trains, stacking tubes, or jumps
- One person per tube (unless child is too small to ride alone)



Snowshoeing/Hiking

- Enjoy various local trails (map at front desk)
- Snowshoes can be rented from The Trailhead in BV at (719) 395-8001

ACTIVITIES NEAR

Downhill Skiing

- Ski Cooper: affordable slope for families and beginner to intermediate skiers. Located in Leadville (1 hr north of SC).
- Monarch: beginner to expert skiers. Located west of Salida (1 hr S.W. of SC).
- Breckenridge: a good deal on the military EPIC pass. Beginner to expert skiers. Located 1.5 hrs northeast of SC. Excellent ski town for shopping.
- Vail: beginner to expert. Included on EPIC pass. Located 1.5 hrs north of SC.
- Beaver Creek: beginner to expert. Included on EPIC pass. Located 2 hrs north of SC.
- Rent skis at Bluebird Mountain Sports or Mountain Sports Haus in Salida, or at any ski resort.



Restaurants

Cross Country Skiing

- Collegiate Peaks Campground: 10 min from SC
- Cottonwood Lake: ski around the campground at Cottonwood Lake or up the road. Snow conditions vary.
- Leadville Golf Course: great groomed course
- Breck Nordic Center: great groomed course
- Brown's Creek: good family run if the snow is good. Snow conditions vary.
- Tennessee Pass: 45 min from SC. Snow always good.
- Mineral Belt Trail: 11.5 mile trail, Leadville (7th St. Access), groomed. 45 min drive.
- Independence Pass: Snow is always good, but may only be trekked out a few miles.
